The Bourbon County Commission met in open door session with all commissioners present. County Coordinator, Jim Harris, was also present.

John Swarts, County Attorney, came before the commissioners to discuss the copier in his office. It is broken. He is in need of purchasing a new one. He asked the commissioners if he could do so in two equal payments over two years. The commissioners okayed the purchase.

Commissioner Query mentioned the committees to which the county was associated. He suggested keeping the same committee assignments as last year. They will review them and discuss them at a later date.

Mr. Query asked Jim Harris to call the Post Office to check on 911 addressing.

Mr. Graham read a request from the City of Bronson for 911 signs. Jim Harris will look into the price of the signs. No action at this time.

Robert Query asked if the county could check into grants for handicap accessible piers at Elm Creek Lake. Mr. Harris will check into it.

The Commission received a letter from the Downtown Program regarding a January 29, 2001, luncheon regarding funding to fix privately owned buildings in the downtown Fort Scott area. No action.

Resolution 01-06 regarding Closed Days for the Transtor Station and Resolution 01-07 a list of warrants to be cancelled that are over two years old, were presented to the commission. Robert Query made a motion to accept Resolution 01-06. Terry Graham seconded. All in favor. Robert Query then made a motion to accept Resolution 01-07. Terry Graham seconded. All in favor. Both Resolutions were signed and placed in Resolution Book 3.
