Seventh, with a budget of \$6 million, are the commissioners still of the mindset that Bourbon County should not have an administrator to run daily business at the county? They are. The eighth item on the list was to make comments about the published budget. Mr. Underwood asked the commissioners to reconsider removing \$120,000 from the Road & Bridge fund. He asked that the county republish the budget after adding it back in.

The commissioners reminded the committee that, as the sales tax will be in a separate fund, all expenditures from the sales tax fund are open records and can be reviewed at any time. The public hearing was closed at 11:05am.

Robert Query made a motion to adopt the 2002 Bourbon County Budget with no revisions. Gary Houston seconded and Terry Graham voted in favor. Four copies of the budget were signed by the commissioners and clerk.

After routine business, the meeting was adjourned at 12:05pm with no further actions.


