Darrin Petrowsky, KDOT, met with commissioners. He gave them an update of the scheduled projects for this summer throughout Bourbon County.




Terry Graham left the meeting at 10:35 am for a medical appointment.

Sharon Elder presented commissioners with information regarding the Heritage Trust Fund grant opportunities.


Judy Orton spoke with commissioners about the flowers along the south sidewalk that are dying. The commissioners authorized her to replace them as she saw fit.
