

Doylene Kennedy spoke to the commissioners about a problem with Cintas, the company who cleans uniforms for the Road & Bridge Department. Ms. Kennedy has found a cheaper alternative but Cintas says Bourbon County has a 5 year contract and must pay it off if we are going to break the contract. As the employees actually pay the fees out of payroll deductions, Ms. Kennedy doesn't think the County is liable. Commissioners asked Ms. Kennedy to speak to the county attorney about it.

Clyde Killion gave a road report. Commissioners asked Mr. Killion to put an illegal dump site clean-up on the spring schedule.

Joanne Long directed commissioners to the budget report for the end of 2003. Though there are encumbrances that are yet to be paid, the General Fund has not exceeded the original published expenditures. This is due to the fact that most departments kept way under budget to make up for the five departments that exceeded their budgets.

After routine business, the meeting adjourned at noon.
