Judy recommends one address for the motel and to use the unit numbers. Commissioners agreed. Ms. Orton will confirm with the fire department that that is allowed.

Sharon Elder asked if the commissioners decided to rescind the KAC resolution from last month. Terry Graham said they would not rescind the resolution but informed Ms. Elder that Joanne Long is the voting delegate and is not bound to vote any certain way.

Mike Gengler, project manager for US 69 Hwy north of Fort Scott, explained survey work and road work his group is doing.
