The Bourbon County Commission met in open session with all commissioners and the county clerk present. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and corrected.

Laura Hyer, reporter with the *Fort Scott Tribune*, was present.

Clyde Killion asked the commissioners about Landfill gate fees. Allen County has raised them \$2.00 per ton again this year. After some discussion, Terry Graham made a motion to raise the fees. Robert Query seconded and all voted in favor. Effective January 1, 2004, the fees are as follows:

Joanne Long reported that the Treasurer's Office received Road & Bridge Sales Tax in the amount of \$70,894.39. Also, the County Treasurer Motor Fund transferred \$22,886.30 into the General Fund at year end.
