The commissioners met in open session with all three commissioners, commissioner elect Barbara Albright, and the county clerk present.

Laurie Sisk, a reporter with the Fort Scott Tribune was also present.

Kendell Mason talked with the commissioners and Marty Pearson about a phone call from Earl Brown, Earl reported that there are culverts near Hiatville that are tearing up tires, he wanted to talk to the commissioners about this. The commissioners asked Marty to call Earl.

Marty reported that at the Blake quarry, they have been tapering corners and are getting ready to move dirt to make a slope. Marty said they still need to cut the spillway for the water to flow out. Marty said he would like to take a soil sample to the extension office to make sure the soil will grow grass. Allen Warren said it might be getting close to doing another walk through with Kenny Blake.

Marty reported that they are going to have to haul dirt to the Inman Bridge and he hopes to have the bridge open in about a week.

Marty said he had filled out the paperwork for T-works for reimbursement for the signs that are being replaced. He says there should be approximately \$33,372.36 reimbursed from T-works.

Marty said he had a loader working at George quarry. Marty also reported that there is approximately 50 ton of rock left at the Beth quarry.

The commissioners opened bids for 82 galvanized culverts, they were as follows...

Judy's Iron & Metal, Inc. = \$26,549.79

Welborn Sales, Inc. = \$23,336.40

Jingles Endicott made a motion to purchase the culverts from Welborn Sales, Inc for \$23,346.40, Allen Warren seconds, all were in favor.

Terri Coop met with the commissioners regarding the emergency management vehicle, she said it isn't reliable and will not start without being jumpstarted. Marty will have the mechanic from Road & Bridge look at the vehicle.

Allen Warren talked with Marty about equipment & the replacement value for what is being insured on the counties insurance.

Deb Hall talked to the commissioners about some questions she had on her tax statement.

Terri Johnson reported that she had checked on the performance bond from the company that had previously repaired the roof, the performance bond has expired. Jingles Endicott made a motion to have the roof repaired having the Kirberg company do the work for \$10,582.00. Harold Coleman seconds and all were in favor.

Terri Johnson asked to go into executive session for 30 minutes for attorney-client matters.

Gene Cowan talked asked the commissioners if there was an ordinance against demolishing a building, transporting and then burning the debris. The commissioners are going to have Terri Coop look into this matter and get back to Gene Cowan on this.

The commissioners adjourned at 11:28.
