The Bourbon County Commission met in open session with all commissioners and the county clerk present.

Laurie Sisk, reporter with the Fort Scott Tribune was also present.

Marty Pearson reported that he would like to purchase the track hoe from Victor L. Phillips and wants to purchase a quick disconnect bucket from them as well for an additional \$8,175 (installed). This would bring the total for the excavator to \$122,675. Allen Warren made a motion to purchase the track hoe & quick disconnect bucket from Victor L. Phillips for \$122,675 with financing through UMB. Harold Coleman seconded & all were in favor.

Marty also reported that AT&T had filled out a permit to bore under 180th and Maple Rd. He also reported that they had done some patching off of 2nd & on Maple Rd. He said the crusher had been spraying oil & he thinks it is a filter, this problem has been reported to Berry Tractor. Marty talked to Shane Walker about purchasing a repeater, Allen Warren told Marty it isn't in the budget to purchase.

Allen Warren asked Marty to check where we were at on our budget with T-Works.

At 9:35 Barbara Albright arrives.

Representatives from SEK-CAP came to talk to the commissioners about a program they are working on, they are trying to get a count of homeless people in different counties, Bourbon County being one of them. They are trying to bring resources together to determine how many homeless people there are in Bourbon County. They will do a survey in April 2013. Jingles Endicott asked if there are a lot of homeless people and SEK-CAP reported that they are seeing an increase in doubled up households (families living with others).

Terri Johnson asked if we had a list of 2009 homestead vs. non homestead properties for the tax sale. The commissioners said that Susan Quick needs to determine abandoned properties.

Terri Johnson talked about a letter from KDHE in regards to the Amish, asked if they are in violation, what do they need to do to comply to regulations. Terri Johnson said the county needs to make sure there aren't others in violation.

Allen Warren talked to Terri Johnson about the Multi County Health Board, wanted to know if salary for those employees could be confidential, Terri Johnson said no.

Terri Johnson asked the commissioners if she could use the new commission rooms TV @ times in District Court the commissioners were all in agreement.

The meeting adjourned at 11:55.
