Submission of applications will be accepted and approval of permits will be granted on these terms and conditions:

1. All application and permit fees are non-refundable.
2. All fees are to be submitted with applications, permits or agreements to the Bourbon County Road and Bridge Department.
3. All permit fees are in addition to necessary and appropriate engineering and road damage fees as well as additional county expenses required by the project.
4. Exceptions, waivers, and special permit fees will be figured on a case by case basis and will be determined and approved by Bourbon County Commissioners.
5. All permit fees shall be submitted fourteen (14) days prior to commencement of work.
6. Duration of all transmission pipeline and access entrance applications and permits shall be:
 - a. Application is valid for 12 months from Notice of Approval date.
 - b. Permit is valid for 18 months from the Application Received date.
7. Duration of all utility and all other applications and permits shall be:
 - a. Application is valid for 3 months from Notice of Approval date.
 - b. Permit is valid for 6 months from the Application Received date.
8. Notice of Approval or Denial will be returned within fourteen (14) days of submission and does not constitute a permit without payment of permit fee.
9. Bourbon County hereby reserves the right to prohibit the use or occupation of specific portions and/or all of the County Public right-of-way.

10. If the County denies a request to use or occupy a specific portion and/or all of the County Public right-of-way, the applicant shall be served a notice of such denial by first class mail. The notice shall indicate that the applicant shall have ten (10) days from the date of receipt of the notice to request a public hearing. Failure to do so shall constitute a waiver of the person's right to contest the denial before the governing body. The hearing shall be held by the governing body within 30 days after the filing of the request therefore, and the applicant shall be advised by Bourbon County of the time and place of the hearing. Following the public hearing, if the County governing body denies an applicant's request to use or occupy a specific portion and/or all of the county right-of-way such determination may be appealed to the district court.
