

The Board of County Commissioners of Bourbon County, Kansas, will receive sealed bids on the prairie and fescue hay that can be mowed on land that the County owns at Elm Creek Lake.

The hay must be removed by August 1, 2024, if not, the winning bidder forfeits his/her rights, money and the hay will revert back to Bourbon County. Bids will be accepted in the County Clerk's Office, 210 S. National Ave., until 4:30 pm, March 22, 2024. All bids must be accompanied by check and sealed with the name and address of the bidder on the envelope. Please clearly mark the outside of the envelope as "Elm Creek hay bid".

Bids will be opened publicly on March 25, 2024 at 5:35 p.m. during the regularly scheduled Commission meeting. All bids are subject to approval of the Board.
